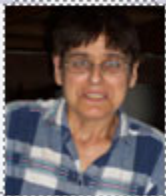

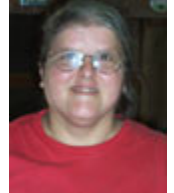

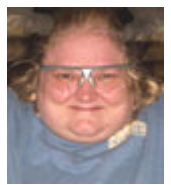

SAFE BICYCLING HEALTH & SAFETY TIPS

RULES OF THE ROAD:

1. The best and smartest bike riders always wear a bike helmet.
2. Ride single-file with traffic.
3. Obey all traffic signs and signals.
4. Use hand signals if you are going to stop or turn.
5. Stop and look left-right-left again before entering a street.
6. Walk you bike across an intersection.
7. Watch out for blind spots.
8. Stay alert for things that could make you fall off your bike.
9. Inspect your bike often.
